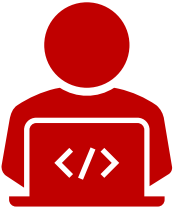

POINTS TO NOTE FOR DESKTOP ASSESSMENT



During Desktop Assessment, ULBs will receive emails for the gaps identified. Please check emails.

- **Cities will get 24 hours to revert on the gaps identified.**
(For example: If email is received today at 3PM, the 24 hour window will be till tomorrow 3PM. However, if email is received today after 6PM, the 24 hour window will start from tomorrow 9AM. Please refer the time in the email body.)
- **No changes are allowed in the GFC portal and all clarifications need to be submitted to TPA over email only.**
- **Please click REPLY ALL to the email received (sample email enclosed) while sending justifications in the column provided and also attach relevant evidence for the particular gap.**

Please note, ULBs shall share requisite documents and details against the gaps identified over email within the 24 hour window to become eligible for further assessment.
